By promoting global collaboration and shared knowledge, GA4GH aims to accelerate research and advance healthcare.

GA4GH brings together experts and institutions worldwide to create tools and standards that support interoperability, responsible data use, and the integration of genomics into healthcare. These standards help streamline data exchange, enhance research capabilities, and strengthen collaboration between national initiatives.



GHGA's Role in GA4GH

As a member of the GA4GH National Initiatives Forum (NIF), GHGA works with leading genomics initiatives like Genomics England and FinnGen to share insights and best practices. GHGA contributes to shaping and implementing GA4GH standards in Germany, developing pilot projects for data sharing with large cohorts, and identifying common needs across initiatives.
